Verdict on Zuma appeals out soon

The Supreme Court of Appeal (SCA) is scheduled to deliver judgment tomorrow on an appeal against search-and-seizure raids on the offices of former deputy president Jacob Zuma and his lawyers being declared invalid.

SCA spokesperson Henry Snyman said judgment would be handed down in four appeals involving Zuma, his lawyers and French arms company Thint.

The National Prosecuting Authority appealed to the SCA against a Durban high court judgment in favour of Zuma and his attorney Michael Hulley.

The high court declared the search warrants invalid and the searches unlawful and ordered the NPA to return all evidence seized to Zuma and Hulley.

The SCA was also expected to deliver judgment in Zuma and Thint's appeal against an application by the National Director of Public Prosecutions to get original documents from Mauritius related to investigations against them. - Sapa
