The docket in this regard has been received by the office of Advocate Rodney de Kock who is the Director of Public Prosecutions (DPP) in the Western Cape. The said office will consider the docket and will decide if any person(s) may be prosecuted and if so on what charge(s). To this end, we are in regular contact with the SAPS with whom we are interacting on this matter.

No undertaking or official announcement regarding the outcome of this process has yet been made.
