RE: SERIAL KILLER & PSYCHOPATH SENTENCED TO FOUR LIFE TERMS & 71 YEARS

The Western Cape High Court sentenced Cameron Wilson to four life terms and 71 years today, after finding him guilty on thirteen counts which include murder, attempted murder, conspiracy to commit crime, rape, possession of an illegal firearm and ammunition and assault with intent to commit grievous bodily harm.

He got four life terms for the murders of Toyher Stober, Stacey Lee Mohale, Lekhita Moore and for the rape of Dawney Davids. Further, the court sentenced him to fifteen years for the murder of Alfonso van Rooyen; five years for possession of an unlicensed firearm and ammunition; fifteen years for the murder of Ernest Johannes Erasmus; ten years for attempted murder and conspiracy to commit a crime; six years for assault with intent to commit grievous bodily harm and ten years for the murder of Roslyn Lakay.

During trial, the court received reports from psychologists who examined and declared Wilson a serial killer and psychopath with very limited chances of being rehabilitated. The court accepted these reports.

Advocate Carine Teunissen who prosecuted the matter, called more than 40 witnesses. The matter was finalised within 51 days.

"We are also very grateful to the two investigating officers who worked day and night under very trying circumstances to ensure that we secure this conviction and sentence. We also want to thank the witnesses who played a very pivotal role in this case. We know that some of them were even threatened but they risked their lives to ensure that these victims of crime get justice. Without these witnesses we would not be where we are today," Advocate Teunissen said.

The NPA welcomes this strong sentence as it is an indicator that the courts will not tolerate the gruesome crimes committed against innocent members of the community and young women.
