Dear Candidates,

On the eve of the entry examinations tomorrow, please note the following IMPORTANT points:

- Due to Covid-19 related restrictions on numbers, the access to the venues will be limited to accommodate all candidates in line with the restrictions. The sizes and formats of the venues differ; some will be able to accommodate more candidates at a time than others (e.g. conference centres and schools have different rooms for different groups and others are just one big venue)
- 2. In instances where the venue is not able to accommodate all candidates at the same time, due to the above-mentioned restrictions; the exam will be written in two or three back-to-back sessions and students will be allocated accordingly, on a first come-first serve basis (other important considerations will also be made for prioritisation, e.g. disability)
- 3. Further, because candidates are allowed to write in venues different from those they have chosen as their centre of choice, this has made it difficult to anticipate how many candidates will turn up at which venue. This is the reason that provision is being made for back-to-back sessions, so that all candidates are accommodated.
- 4. Please arrive early (07:30 for the first session at 09:00) to allow for the required screening processes. You will be required to fill in a Covid-19 questionnaire and this will also serve as confirmation of your attendance for the entry examination.
- 5. The session(s) are 3 hours, no extra time will be allocated.
- 6. NO MASK, NO ENTRY
